Dear Coaches and Managers,

Thank you for including the 29th Annual River Falls Invitational Tournament in your spring - summer schedule. We are delighted to have 60+ teams participate in our tournament this year. I have attached the game brackets, map of the area and tournament field sites. This information is also posted on our website at www.rfwildcatsoccer.org. If you are interested in accommodations (hotels, restaurants, activities, etc.), I have listed two websites to assist you: www.RFChamber.com and www.Hudsonwi.org. There will be also concessions at the fields.

Tournament headquarters will be near the parking lot at the North end of Meyer Middle School. Rules of the tournament are available on-line so please review our website. Please check in at the tournament headquarters at least 30 minutes before your first game. Headquarters will be open on Friday from 5-7pm and Saturday at 7am through closure. Player cards need to be verified and stamped before your first game. You will need to complete a game roster for RFWS and one for each game you play. Player cards and signed medical release forms will also be checked at this time.

All rostered players will receive a tournament pin. All U9 and U10 players will receive a tournament medal that will be awarded at the tournament headquarters following your last game. There are no recorded scores for the U9 and U10 teams. They are all "Winners".

U11 through U16 games will be scored according to the tournament point system explained in the rules. Whether your team advances or is awarded a medal is based on tournament points earned. All players on first and second place teams will receive individual medals. Following your last game, come to the tournament headquarters for an award ceremony.

A severe weather policy is explained in the rules. In case of severe weather, report to your first game as scheduled for further information.

Parking shouldn't be an issue, but please arrive early. Please inform your players and parents to respect the property and privacy of those living near the fields. Pets, smoking and alcohol use are prohibited on all tournament grounds.

In closing, we are looking forward to a great weekend of soccer!!!!
